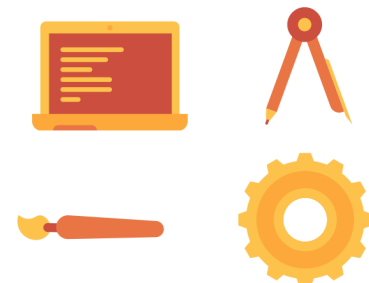

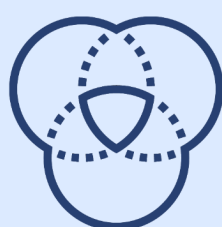


LEARNER PROFILE

Demonstrate sensitivity to diverse cultures, audiences or contexts when working with others.

3 EXHIBIT

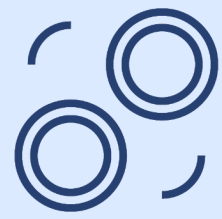


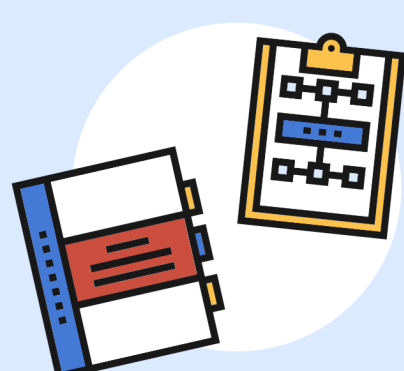
Exhibit reciprocity and trust when sharing ideas or roles.

STRATEGIES AND IDEAS



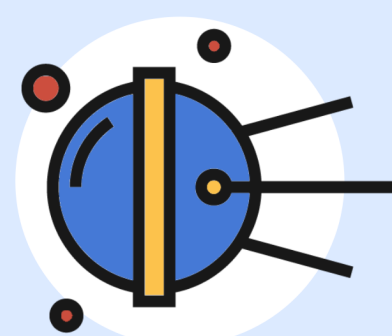
Develop norms for working together with your students.



Help students foster collaboration through shared leadership, responsibility or ownership.



Teach/encourage students to learn about and apply appropriate ways of working together within a group to demonstrate respect.



Provide project-based and experiential learning opportunities and classroom routines that develop communication and cooperative work skills.
